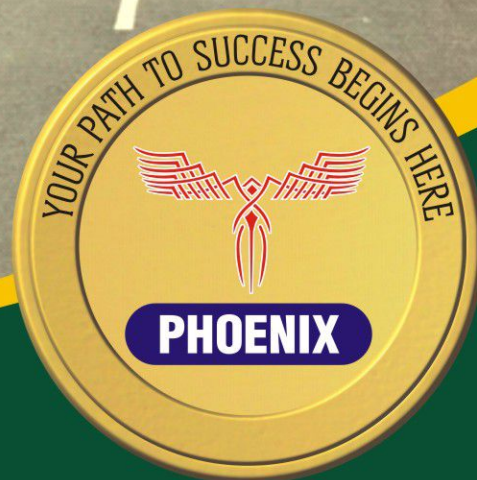

Admissions

Eligibility Criteria for GNM Admission (3 yrs)

Age for admission of the candidate shall be 17 to 35 years.

Minimum education qualification shall be 10+2 class passed or its equivalent in any stream with aggregate of 40% marks.

Students should be medically fit.

Students shall be admitted once in a year.

Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc (N) Admission (4 yrs)

Age for admission of the candidate shall be 17 to 35 years.

Minimum education qualification shall be 10+2 class passed or its equivalent in medical stream (PCB) with aggregate of 45% marks.

Student must have appeared in the Punjab Para Medical Entrance Test (PPMET) conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences– Faridkot.

Admission of students shall be once in a year.

Students should be medically fit.

Eligibility Criteria for P.B. B.Sc (N) Admission (2 yrs)

For minimum education qualification, a student should have passed GNM.

Student must have appeared in the Punjab Post Basic Nursing Entrance Test (PPBNET) conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences– Faridkot.

Admission Of Students Shall Be Once In A Year.

Students Should Be Medically Fit.

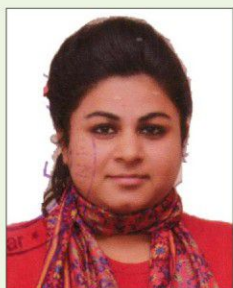

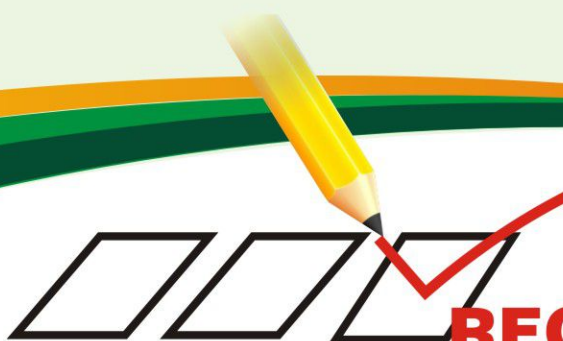

Institution Rules

- Students shall comply with Institutions Rules & Regulations.
- Discipline of the Institute is to be strictly observed. If discipline is breached, the student shall be expelled from the Institute.
- Regular and punctual attendance at lectures and practical demonstration is compulsory.
- In the class-room, students shall be properly dressed in uniform as per the instructions directed by BFUHS.
- Students shall maintain silence in the library at all times.
- Students missing clinical training are required to make up during their vacations or they will not be declared passed in their current examination.
- Students are forbidden to address any outside authority directly.
- Institute does not hold itself responsible for student's debts whatsoever.
- The decision of the Principal in all academic disputes would be final and binding on students.
- Students are not allowed to have any visitor(s) in the class-room or while working in the clinical area.
- Students are not allowed to arrange their clinical experience on their own.
- Ragging of students is not permitted and shall be a punishable offence.
- Students are strictly forbidden from appearing in any other examinations/course during the period of training.
- Students must get minimum 50% marks in all the monthly tests/examinations.
- Any grievance/complaint of the student is to be brought to the notice of the Principal, who will help in resolving at the earliest. In case of unsatisfactory redressal of issue at hand, the student can approach the management of the Institution.
- Student shall have 90% attendance for all the theoretical classes and 100% attendance for clinical duties to sit for the final exams.
- Fee can be deposited by cash or cheque/demand draft in favour of Seth Bishamber Nath Charitable Society.
- Fees must be deposited within the stipulated time in order to avoid fine of Rs.10/- per day as late fee.
- Students can get permission for leave from the Principal, only in case of emergency.
- Students are advised not to wear any expensive ornament/ jewellery in the Hostel/Class Rooms/Clinical areas. In case any loss or mishap, the Institution does not take any responsibility whatsoever.
- In case of indiscipline or misbehavior by the student, strict disciplinary action will be taken against such student and based on the gravity of offence, in some cases expulsion from the institution.
- Sick leave will be given only to the student, if it is recommended by a hospital doctor. To avail such sick leaves; a medical certificate is to be produced by the concerned student.

Hostel Rules

- Students will not be allowed to use any heavy electric appliance in the hostel.
- Visitors can visit the students only on Sunday from 9am to 5pm in the visitor's room only.
- Relatives or parents are not allowed in the hostel.
- Day scholars are not allowed to stay in the hostel.
- Students are not to keep extra money or anything costly in the hostel. Management is not responsible for its loss whatsoever.
- Without prior information, the authorities have right to search hostel or students personal belongings any time to maintain discipline and decorum of the jostle.
- Students will be sent home, with the parents/guardians (whose photograph is being given to us in visitor list) once in two months for a maximum period of two days.
- Leave will not be granted to any student until and unless there is a genuine emergency..
- Students should be modestly dressed inside & outside the campus during the course of their study.
- Students are allowed to go out off the campus only on 2nd Saturday of the month from 10am to 2pm only.
- Students will not be allowed to use mobile phones inside the class rooms.
- Wastage of food is not allowed in the hostel. Food should not be taken inside the hostel room.
- The students who keep their room and surroundings neat and clean are encouraged.
- Students should bring their own articles at the time of joining e.g. blanket & quilt, two bed sheets, pillow with pillow cover, plastic bucket with mug, stationary items, black full sleeves sweater, white stockings, utensils like steel plates, spoon, glass etc.
- A complete list of relatives or visitors (with photographs who will visit you during your stay here, which needs to be duly signed by father/guardian).
- Letter of permission from guardian to travel alone.
- Water and electricity are becoming very scarce and therefore students are advised that lights, fans and other electrical devices should be switched off when not in use, in order to avoid penal action. Also every student shall
- ensure that any water taps are properly closed near their premises, so to avoid any wastage of water.
- Any damage to the hostel, institution or hospital property will be compensated by the student.
- In case of indiscipline in the hostel, after enquiry student may be asked to vacate the hostel immediately.
- The management has the right to revise rules & regulations from time to time.
- It may be noted that the above mentioned rules and regulations are not exhaustive in nature.

Fee Particulars

Fee will be charged as per the directions of the Punjab Nurses Registration Council ("PNRC"), Chandigarh and Baba Farid University of Health Sciences ("BFUHS"), Faridkot.

In order to make smooth functioning for the welfare of the students, the Institute has made General Rules for payment of college Dues, which are the following:-

- Students admitted in any course especially 1st year will be required to make full payment.
- That as per the notification of Government of Punjab vides order no. 5/48/2007- 3HB3/1982 dated 31-03-2008 Page No.10, Note No.2. *"I hereby submit a Bank Guarantee/bond that I will be liable to pay the balance fee for the whole course even if I will leave in midstream."*
- Payment of fees by the candidates of all the categories must be made either by a Bank Draft or by Cheque (s) drawn in favor of **"Seth Bishamber Nath Charitable Society"**.
- The fees are provisional and subject to change in accordance with the decision of the Courts/Govt. of Punjab/BFUHS etc.
- In case a student leaves the institution/college during academic session, he/she will have to deposit all the dues for that particular course.
- Students who are not paying the dues within 30 days after the scheduled date, the name of that particular student will be struck off from the college rolls and subsequently will be reported to the PNRC & BFUHS. Such student may be re-admitted on payment of re-admission fee and fine @ INR 10/day, if allowed by the Principal.
- In case a student has got his/her name struck off from the college rolls, by submitting an application to the principal, he/she will be liable to pay the dues including for the period of absence.

Students, who are not paying the dues, will not be allowed to appear in any of the examinations.

- Any issue/litigation in respect to fees , admission etc will be subject to the jurisdiction of Jalandhar, Punjab.

Student Welfare Activities

- Suggestions and Feedback activities e.g. suggestion boxes have been installed in the administrative as well as hostel building, so that the nursing student can give any suggestion/complaint in order to ensure more smooth functioning of the institution as we believe in two way communication practices.
